Jun 7: Your adventure begins with your **flights to Anchorage**, Alaska... where you will meet your local guide. Transfer to your hotel. Welcome to Alaska! Overnight in Anchorage.

Jun 8: This morning, it's all aboard the **McKinley Explorer**, **Holland America's famous Domed Train** bound for Denali. Sit back and relax onboard this luxurious train - there is nothing between you and the great outdoors! Optional meals & beverages available onboard the train. Two nights in Denali.

Jun 9: Today features the unforgettable **Tundra Wilderness Tour**. This 6-8 hour, fully narrated sightseeing excursion takes you into the heart of Denali National Park. This tour offers the best opportunity to view Denali's iconic wildlife and North America's tallest peak. (snack included). Balance of day at leisure in **Denali**.

Jun 10: Today we head to **Fairbanks**, Alaska's Golden Heart City, and take a step back in time aboard the Sternwheeler Riverboat Discovery with lunch included. Evening at leisure in **Fairbanks**.

Jun 11: Our journey continues on a short flight to colorful **Dawson City** in the Yukon Territory. Once the pulsing heart of the Klondike Gold Rush, Dawson City today is a cluster of wooden sidewalks and charming frontier-era shops on the banks of the Yukon River. Overnight in **Dawson**.

Jun 12: This morning is free for optional excursions. In the afternoon, see the original Discovery Claim that triggered the Klondike Gold Rush. Enjoy time at **Gold Dredge #4** while a Parks Canada guide shares the history of gold dredging in the area. Overnight in **Dawson**.

Jun 13: Board a short flight to **Whitehorse**, the capital of Canada's Yukon Territory. Whitehorse stands at mile 918 of the Alaska Highway and has the world's lowest level of air pollution! During the Klondike Gold Rush, prospectors washed up here, past two major river obstacles: Miles Canyon and Whitehorse Rapids. Today it remains a popular stop for the Yukon Wildlife Preserve. This afternoon we continue along the Klondike Trail to **Skagway, Alaska**. Overnight in Skagway.

Jun 14: This morning enjoy a ride on the famous historic **White Pass Railroad**, a classic narrow-gauge railway that traverses rugged mountains and passes cascading waterfalls and towering glaciers as it connects Skagway to Whitehorse deep in the Yukon. This is a must do while in Skagway! Afternoon & evening at leisure to enjoy one of the most popular towns in Alaska. At the height of the Klondike Gold Rush, Skagway was the gateway to the gold fields, and quickly grew into Alaska's largest settlement. It was then a raucous frontier hub packed with trading posts, saloons and guesthouses. At every turn, you'll find yourself immersed in gold rush lore, from the infamous Red Onion Saloon that still keeps a pistol that Wyatt Earp left behind en route to the Klondike. Overnight in **Skagway**.

Jun 15: Today we board the **Koningsdam** - your home for the next 4 nights. All meals are included during your cruise with Holland America's famous service & cuisine.

Jun 16: **Glacier Bay National Park**—comprised of ever-changing glaciers, sheltered fjords, rainforests and an abundance of wildlife—this is the most sought after spot in Alaska! Get your cameras ready!

Jun 17: **Ketchikan, Alaska** - lush rainforest, crystalline lakes & so much more

Jun 18: **Scenic Cruising the Inside Passage** What a wonderful way to end your cruise!

Jun 19: **Vancouver, Canada**— We arrive in Vancouver and transfer to the airport for our flights home.

Optional Tours will be offered in each port of call during your cruise and during any free time you have on land. Please note: Meals on land portion are not included. Meal plans are available for purchase.

Cancellation Penalty: If cancelled after deposit and before Feb 23, 2027 fee of \$150.pp; Feb 24-Mar 10, 2027 fee of 50% of total fare; Mar 11-Apr 11, 2027 fee of 75% of total fare; No refunds after Apr 11, 2027. Air penalties are not included in above and may be additional.

TRIP PROTECTION COVERAGE:

Travel Protection offers coverage for Cancellation for Covered Medical Reasons, Trip Interruption, Emergency Medical Services, Travel Delay, & more. Cancel for Any Reason (CFAR) coverage can be purchased from either provider (see timing guidelines below) and will reimburse up to 75% of prepaid nonrefundable trip costs if canceled at least 48 hours prior to your trip for a non-covered reason.

Insurance Premiums are non-refundable. Terms and conditions apply.

NTA (AON) Travel Protection Plan is based on the cost of the trip and offers 3 levels of insurance: Basic, Enhanced, or Enhanced with CFAR. Emergency medical coverage is secondary coverage. The pre-existing medical condition exclusion can be waived by purchasing the Enhanced Plan or the Enhanced with CFAR Plan within 14 days of initial trip payment.

Policy must be purchased within 14 days (for Deluxe) or 21 days (for Platinum) of your initial payment to have the pre-existing medical condition exclusion waived and to purchase CFAR coverage.
